**Gary L. JACOBSON** 68, of Loveland, went home to his heavenly Father on Aug. 23, 2008.

Gary was born April 17, 1940, in Madison, Wis., to Irving Roy Jacobson and Minnie Ellen Blann Jacobson. He married Cecilia Stern on June 18, 1965, in Stuttgart, Germany. The couple moved to Loveland in July 1966 from Stuttgart.

He graduated from West High in Madison, Wis., in 1958 and graduated from the University of Wisconsin, Madison, in 1964 with a mechanical engineering degree. He worked for two years with IBM in Germany and then as an engineer with Hewlett-Packard in Loveland. Later, he owned his own plastic injection molding company, MIMCO. Following his retirement, he started his new career as a rancher on his ranch on the Buckhorn Creek northwest of Loveland.
